



MLC Aquatic Code of Conduct for Travel

This code applies to all persons attending or representing MLC Aquatic Swimming Club on trips arranged by the Club or where the Club is represented.

1. As a representative of MLC Aquatic it is expected that swimmers, parents, coaches and supporters behave in a manner that reflects positively on MLC, the Club and their families at all times.
2. All MLC, MLC Aquatic, Swimming Australia and Swimming Victoria Codes of Conduct and rules are to be adhered to.
3. Disrespect of person or property will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
4. Breaches of any Code of Conduct or Rules may lead to expulsion from the trip.
5. In the event that a swimmer is expelled from a trip;
 - The parents or guardians will be contacted and asked to collect the person,
 - Any expenses incurred will be the responsibility of the individual or their parents,
 - A full written report will be submitted to the MLC Aquatic Committee of Management and the College,
 - The Committee of Management will assess the breach and may implement further sanctions or penalties as appropriate.
6. The Head Coach has the ultimate responsibility of the conduct of all individuals at a meet or on tour and will determine the course of action required in any given situation.
7. All instructions from the Coach and Team Manager are to be adhered to. Any problems or difficulties are to be raised with the Team Manager.
8. Any problems experienced by swimmers or parents are to be reported to the Head Coach.
